

The Iffley Festival of Miles Event information for the BMC Grand Prix



Please note the new arrangements for car parking this year.

Stadium entry:

There is no race entry fee, but there will be a stadium entry fee of £5 per person. The gates will open at 12:30pm. There will be a separate entry desk for the earlier open races, so make sure to pay at the BMC desk.

For competitors:

The first race will start at 3:30pm. There is a public grass warm-up area at the corner of Meadow Lane/Jackdaw Lane. The rugby club is private property and access is not permitted.

Travelling to Iffley Road:

Please allow plenty of time to travel to Oxford, as some of the roads in the area can be quite narrow.

There is pedestrian access to the track off Iffley Road (opposite Marston Street; OX4 1EQ), and also via Jackdaw Lane.

Please note that new restrictions at the sports centre mean there is <u>NO ONSITE PARKING</u> for athletes/competitors this year. Instead, parking is at the St Mary and St John Primary School, OX4 1TJ, which is just a 5-10 minute walk to the track. Vehicle access to the school is via Daubeny Rd (off Iffley Rd), right onto Warwick St and left onto Bedford St (https://goo.gl/maps/73sMLxHm89w). There is no vehicle access along Meadow Lane, and residents' parking restrictions are enforced.



There is a charge of £5 per car, and the car park will be open from 12-7:30pm.

Parking for disabled people is possible by arrangement with the sports centre.
